As of Monday, March 23, 2020, Athens Utilities Board main lobby will be closed to walk-in services until further notice. You can call (423)745-4501 to speak with customer service, to have someone assist you in making a payment over the phone, or to set up an appointment if you need to meet with an AUB representative. As of 10 a.m. on March 18, 2020, AUB is also temporarily suspending disconnections and late fees for non-payment for customers experiencing financial hardship by the coronavirus (COVID-19) threat until April 3.
